2020-2021 Community Involvement Graduation Requirement

As a result of the challenges that graduating students are facing in acquiring the 40 hours of community service because of Covid-19, the Ministry of Education has revised the requirement for the current school year.

The community involvement graduation requirement for the 2020-2021 school year has been reduced from 40 to a minimum of **20** hours.

Students may also consider virtual volunteering opportunities or outdoor volunteer opportunities to fulfill the community involvement requirement.

The Ministry of Education has also increased flexibility in how **all** secondary students can earn hours during the 2020-2021 school year.

- Principal's may waive some previous restrictions to allow students to earn community involvement hours during the school day or allow duties performed in the home.
- 10 hours of paid employment may also be counted for students 14 years of age or older at the principal's discretion. A reflection exercise explaining how these 10 hours contributed to the service of others must be completed.
